## REVERSE PATSOMES STABLEFORD

## Format, Scoring, Handicap Allowance

Team competition played under strokeplay rules, scored as in stableford.

| Holes | PLAYED AS | HANDICAP STROKES RECEIVED |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| 1 to 6 | Foursomes | 50\% of the combined playing handicaps. |
| 7 to 12 | Greensomes |  |
| 13 to 18 | Better Ball | Full playing handicap. |

## Course Adjustment

If a team is "mixed", both players play off the men's tee's stroke indexes and PARs consequently there is course adjustment. If the team is of the same gender, both players play off their own tee's stroke indexes and PARs consequently there is no course adjustment. Each player plays a normal game of stableford. You should pick up if unable to score any stableford points on a hole.

## Description

Teams comprise two players. The first six holes are played in Better Ball format, the next six in Greensomes format and the last six in Foursomes format. For descriptions of each of these formats please refer to the relevant page.

As in a normal stableford competition a player should "pick up" if he/she or his/her team is unable to score any stableford points on a hole. That hole should be marked in the relevant score column(s) as a - (minus).

Scoring: To decide which holes to take shots on look at the team strokes for holes 1 to 12 and the individual strokes for holes 13 to $\mathbf{1 8}$. The team will receive 1 (or 2 ) shots on each hole 1 to 12 that has a stroke index less than or equal to the team's stroke allowance. An individual will receive 1 (or 2 ) shots on each hole 13 to 18 that has a stroke index less than or equal to the individual's stroke allowance.

- for the first twelve holes the gross score must be recorded for the team under "Score" column A for each hole;
- for the last six holes the gross score must be recorded for each player in the respective "Score" column and the stableford score should also be recorded there;
- for each hole the team's stableford score should be recorded in the "points" column.

Both the marker and one of the players from the relevant team must sign the card.

## Example

A team consists of Jake Nicklaus and Flora Davies.

| StROKES RECEIVED |  |
| :---: | :---: |
| Jake gets one shot on holes: | $13,14,16,17$ and 18 |
| Jake gets two shots on hole: | 15 |
| Flora gets one shot on holes: | 14,15 and 6 |
| The team gets one shot on holes: | $1,3,5,6,7,9$ and 10 |

The scorecard for such a scenario follows.
