October Report

- Fairways have been aerated with the Earthquake machine. Fairways were also scarified in readiness for the Winter over-seeding.
- Landscaped areas have all been pruned and tidied.
- Irrigation audit revealed 5 faulty sprinklers with a further 200 clogged with algae, these have now been repaired. Sprinklers were moved on holes 1 & 18 to improve grass coverage.
- Mole crickets were treated in the greens and collars..
- Chipping Green area damaged by construction has now been repaired.
- Damaged stonework is currently undergoing reparation.
- Green, tees, surrounds and fairways sprayed with liquid fertilizer and plant growth regulator. Greens additionally treated with fungicide and algaecide.
- The vice president of Troon Golf, Simon Doyle visited Minthis last week, in order to produce a full report of recommendations needed to take the golf course to the next level.

November Objectives

- To over-seed the fairways with Winter Ryegrass.
- To fertilize the golf course with granular fertilizer.
- To overseed and repair the small scar patches in the greens.
- To re-seed the turf nursery.
- Complete the stonework repairs.
- To aerate and fertilize the high traffic worn areas in the rough.

- To treat Mole Crickets in Greens and Tees.
- To aerate the Surrounds with 15mm Solid Tines.
- To verti-cut and lightly spike the greens.
- Prune Golf Academy scrub and bushes in preparation for opening.
