

Conditions of Entry for Minthis Competitions

- For entry to FUN and CLUB QUALIFYING competitions:
 - The handicap eligibility is full course playing handicap from WHS Handicap Index for both men and ladies, unless stated differently in the rules for an individual competition.
 - All players must have submitted at least 8 scorecards to WHS for handicap purposes before being eligible to enter competition competitively. Players not meeting this criteria may play, but for Handicap scoring purposes only.
- Eligibility for OPEN competitions shall be noted on the Rules of Entry Form.
- The normal entry fee of €5 per person per competition must be paid (in the Pro shop) before commencement of play. The fee's may vary as identified on the relevant admin sheets.
- Optional 2's competitions will be identified on the relevant admin sheets. This is a separate competition to the main competition. 2's are still paid out even with a No Return score. A Hole in One supersedes the 2's scores.
- Unless specified otherwise for individual competitions, caddies are permitted in any of the competitions, however they can only help ball spot, find lost balls, score, rake bunkers, provide other care for the course, help with clarification of Rules and talk to the players. **They must not give advice.** If a caddie does give advice the caddie's player will be penalised the General Penalty for each offense.
- Buggies are permitted for all competitions including Club Championship.
- Eligibility for playing in the Major Club Competitions (Captains Shoot Out and Club Championship) is competing in 3 Qualifying Competitions (Stableford or Medal) in the previous 12 months before competition.
- Club Championship, if there is a tie after 36 holes then a 2 hole play-off (holes 1 and 9) will determine the winner. If there is still a tie then a sudden death play-off over the same holes will continue until a winner is successful.

- For FUN competitions if the competition is suspended due to extreme weather conditions the maximum suspension will be limited to 1 hour before abandonment. The committee have the option to reduce the competition to 9 holes if everyone has completed 9 holes if abandonment is only option.
- For QUALIFYING and OPEN competitions if the competition is suspended due to extreme weather conditions the Club Professional, Caddie Master and Head Greenkeeper will advise on suspension time and/or abandonment.
- In the rare occurrence that a competition is abandoned the competition will be deemed null and void and all entry fees and optional 2's monies will be refunded.
- QUALIFYING competitions abandoned or cancelled due to extreme weather will be re-scheduled where possible otherwise they will be deemed null and void.
- All players entered and signed up for competitions are required to inform the Proshop and/or competitions secretary if they need to withdraw from the competition. This must be advised before the competition starts. Failure to do so will result in ban from the next 1 or 2 club competitions at the Committee's discretion.
